

Transcript of Interview with Joey Cards

Interview by Lt. Honor Mayfield

January 29, 2022 - 12:36 AM

1) Q: This is the interview of Joey Cards by Lieutenant Honor Mayfield on Sunday, January 29, 2022 at the Anchor, Rhode Island Police Station. How are you, Joey? It has been a long time.

A: I don't mean to tell you your business, but aren't you going to Mirandize me?

2) Q: No need – you are not under arrest, and you are free to go at any time. This is just a friendly chat.

A: Friendly - right. Whaddya want, Mayfield?

3) Q: I just have a few questions about where you were last night around 8:00 PM?

A: Like?

4) Q: Well... where were you?

A: Why you gotta give me such a hard time, Mayfield? Is this another "Hate on Joey game you are playing? This is gettin' old, man!

5) Q: Just answer the question, Cards. Where were you last night at 8:00 PM?

A: I was home watching the Hallmark Channel.

6) Q: Is that right? What was on?

A: A movie called Goodnight for Justice. I don't think you'd like it.

7) Q: Do you have any witnesses who can vouch for you?

A: My cat, Sandy. You're welcome to bring her in, but I'm warning you, she's a tough nut to crack.

8) Q: What about your mom? Would she be more helpful if I brought her in?

A: (Yelling) You leave my mama out of this, Mayfield! She ain't got nothing to do with this!

9) Q: "Nothing to do with this"? What "this," Joey? What are you talking about now?

A: I dunno, Mayfield. You're the one that hauled my happy backside in here for this "friendly chat." You tell me....

10) Q: Do you know Al Plunket?

A: Why?

11) Q: I'm the one asking the questions. Do you know him?

A: Well, I know of Al. Who doesn't?

12) Q: What do you mean?

A: C'mon, Lieutenant. Al is a one-man SBA. If you need money and the banks turn you down, there's always Al.

13) Q: So you know of Al but don't know Al?

A: Sure. That sounds good.

14) Q: So then you've never done any kind of business with him then, have you?

A: Like what? Borrow money? Nah. I'm good, I don't need 'em for that.

15) Q: You've never met him face to face regarding a loan?

A: Uh, can't say that I have. I don't like to hang around with criminal elements like him or his goons. I try to steer clear of 'em all.

16) Q: So you were nowhere near the Anchor Parking Deck last night, around 8:00 PM?

A: Didn't I already say I wasn't there? You must either be deaf or dumb. Which is it, Lieutenant?

17) Q: Hey, while you're here, do you mind if I swab of your hands real quick? It won't hurt.

A: For what? No, I don't think so. I don't trust you, Mayfield.... there's no telling what you claim you might "find" with your little Q-tips and stuff....

18) Q: Alright, no problem. We can get it later. So, let's get back to the garage: there isn't anyone who would say that they saw you meeting with Al on top of that parking garage last night?

A: Who says I was?


19) Q: You'll see. Just answer the question.

ANCHOR POLICE DEPARTMENT INCIDENT REPORT

01/31/2022

911 fielded a call from Leslie McCloud at 20:13 requesting police and ambulance to the Anchor Parking Garage at 654 Main Street, saying someone may have been pushed over the edge of top level of deck. I arrived at 20:19 and found deceased, Al Plunket, face down on northern driveway of parking garage property. Al Plunket was wearing dark overcoat, khakis, and leather dress shoes. After EMS arrived, the body was turned over and single gunshot wound was discovered in right shoulder. No exit wound was visible on back of shoulder. Scratch marks were found on forearms of deceased. I spoke with garage attendant on duty, Leslie McCloud, whose recollection was sparse and unhelpful, as she/he/they professed to know nothing except seeing the body hit the ground. I searched among ground cover and bushes for additional evidence, finding a .32 caliber Bersa semi-automatic pistol. Firearm was photographed (evidence marker #1) and bagged for transport to sheriff's office.

I then proceeded to top level of parking structure via north stairwell. At the top level, several lights were not functioning. I asked for portable lights to be brought in but was told by dispatch all were being used for traffic and pedestrian control around arena for concert. A shell casing (evidence marker #2) was located in middle of deck. A few blood droplets were located near the rail (evidence marker #3). A swab was taken for DNA testing. A scarf (evidence marker #8) was also located near shell casing and blood droplets.

Alongside the northern side of elevator shaft, a cigarette butt (evidence marker #6) and a second shell casing (evidence marker #5) was found. I then walked down to the south stairwell and found another set of blood droplets (evidence marker #9). A swab was taken for DNA testing. Due to the poor lighting conditions, the photographs did not turn out well. I decided to secure the scene and return the following morning to better process and collect the evidence. Pop-up tents were used to cover areas containing evidence from the elements. After securing the top level of the deck, I proceeded back down to the driveway of the garage. I then released the body to the coroner's office for transport to the lab for autopsy. I was stationing two uniformed officers at the driveway for the evening to secure the scene when I was approached by Rory Plunket. Rory approached from across Main Street where she/he/they had parked Plunket's Ford Anglia. Rory said that she/he/they had been in the car on the top level of the deck when Al had held a meeting with Joey Cards. Rory told me that she/he/they witnessed Cards shoot Al and then throw him over the edge. Rory didn't know where the gun came from or if Al carried a gun. After Cards threw Al over the rail, Cards ran down the ramp to the south stairwell and down the stairs. Rory said she/he/they panicked, got into the driver seat, and drove the car out of the garage out onto Carley Avenue and parked across the street. I asked Rory why she/he/they didn't come forward earlier and she/he/they said she/he/they was trying to calm down and get "my thoughts in order". I asked Rory several questions about the events and if she/he/they was sure it was Cards who shot and pushed Al over the edge and she/he/they said "Yes, it was definitely Cards. I saw the whole thing clear as day. You can't let her/him/they get away with this!" I then called Rory's mother to come get Rory and take her/him/they home. I then went back to the station with blood swabs and the gun. I examined the gun and processed it for fingerprints, ballistics evidence and serial number ownership. The serial number was filed off. A single latent fingerprint was found on the slide of the gun and run through AFIS. AFIS had no matches. I compared fingerprint to the 10 card on file with the department of Joey Cards and found a 9-point match to Cards' right ring finger. No other usable fingerprints were found on gun. A round was then fired into the lab's bullet trap to get a comparison sample for the firearm. This will be used to run against open cases as well as the round from Al's shoulder once the ME gets to the lab.

I then asked a uniform officer to ask Joey Cards to come down to the Anchor Station for an interview about the events. Cards arrived a few minutes after midnight, 1/29, and was put into Interrogation Room 2. Cards claimed that she/he/they was home all evening watching a movie on TV, A Good Night for Justice. Cards was defensive, nervous, and emotional. When I

informed Cards that we had a witness putting her/him/they on the roof with Al, she/he/they got even more nervous, asked if she/he/they was free to leave and almost ran out of the room. A transcript of the interview will be included with the supplemental report. At 7:20 Sunday morning, I went back to the garage to re-photograph the scene. All of the evidence tents were still in place, along with their evidence. The pop-up tents were removed and pictures were retaken and all evidence collected. The cigarette butt was sent for DNA testing. Both shell casings were sent for ballistics testing. The large scene pictures accurately show where everything was from the night before. Using better light, the rail of the garage where the deceased was pushed over was inspected for fingerprints. Three latent prints were located (evidence marker #7) and lifted for processing. They were taken back to the lab to be run through AFIS. Having enough actionable evidence, I went to the residence of Joey Cards at 8:44 AM to place Cards under arrest for the murder of Al Plunket. Upon arriving at the residence, Cards claimed no involvement with Al's death. GSR tests came back negative on both of Cards' hands.

ANCHOR POLICE DEPARTMENT INCIDENT REPORT

02/05/2022

After Joey Cards was arrested and booked on 1/29, I started processing all of the evidence collected from the scene. The two unprocessed fingerprints (Print card #2 from the shell casing - Evidence marker #2; and Print card #3 from the rail - Evidence marker #7) were sent to the latent lab. The lab technician ran the prints through AFIS. The fingerprint from the shell casing came back to Jesse Williams. The rail prints came back to Rory Plunket. With the information about Rory's prints on the rail, I questioned him/her/they about it and she/he/they said they didn't remember going to the rail after Al was pushed, but may have, that that part of the events was "fuzzy".

The blood samples were sent to the DNA lab to be run against samples taken from Al Plunket and Cards. Al's known sample was taken during the autopsy. Cards' was taken from a cheek swab during the intake processing at Anchor Prison. The blood droplets near the rail (Evidence marker #3) were from Al Plunket, most likely when he was punched by Cards during their struggle. The blood droplets by the south stairwell door (Evidence marker #9) were a match to Joey Cards.

The cigarette butt (Evidence marker #6) by the elevator shaft had enough of a DNA sample for a comparison. The lab ran the sample through the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS) and it found a match to Jesse Williams. His/her/their DNA was in CODIS from previous arrests for a gun charge and possession of narcotics. The cigarette butt seemed fresh in that the smell of nicotine was still present and it was dry, as if it had not been in the elements of the evening very long. While that part of the pavement was shielded from the snowfall by the elevator shaft, I concluded the butt had been dropped there within an hour or two of my arrival.

During the processing of Cards at the jail, I performed a gunshot residue test on Cards' hands but it came up negative. I was not surprised since it had been several hours since the shooting and there had been ample time for Cards to wash it off. I interviewed Jesse Williams at approximately 8:00 PM on Sunday, January 29 about his/her/their knowledge of the events of the previous evening. Williams claimed that s/he/they was/were at a movie at the Anchor Place Mall watching "Flatliners". Williams said that s/he/they went to the movie alone and didn't have anyone to verify his/her/their presence. I asked for the movie ticket stub but Williams said s/he/they threw it away on the way out of the theater. I asked if there was a credit card receipt or other payment proof and s/he/they said s/he/they had paid cash for the ticket, large Coke Zero, and medium Raisinets.

On January 31, I was contacted by Devan Johnson, a resident in the apartment building across Carley Avenue from the garage. Johnson claims to have seen A1 get pushed over the edge but couldn't give a good description of the pusher or where they went. Johnson kept wanting to talk about what s/he/they had seen over the past several months regarding Al's meetings on the top of the garage and insisted that I take a set of photographs s/he/they had supposedly taken of some of the meetings earlier. Johnson was very insistent that something should have been done about Al's criminal activity, as well as the drug dealing done in and around the garage and that if s/he/they had been "listened to earlier, none of this would have happened." To oblige Johnson and leave the conversation, I accepted the photographs and promised to add them to the file, even though they didn't have any evidentiary value to the events of the 28th.

On the morning of February 5, I passed along all of my findings and conclusions to the District Attorney's office for their use with the prosecution of the case.


